

Summer Band Form 2016 – Incoming 6th-8th Grade Students Only

Registration Information:

Registration will be open from February 1st through April 15th

The Summer Band Event will run from Monday, June 6-Thursday, June 16. There will be no session on Friday, June 10.

- Incoming 6th Grade Students will attend from 8am-10:15am
- Incoming 7th Grade Students will attend from 9:15am-11:30am
- Incoming 8th Grade Students will attend from 10:30am-12:45pm
- A finale concert will be presented on Thursday, June 16 at 7pm (location TBD)

How to Register:

There are two choices! Complete the online registration by submitting the form and using a credit card to pay for the fee. We highly encourage this option. The second option is to print the form. Please print the registration form, bring it to your child's base school or mail to their base school by the deadline above. Note that the **FEE** is due at the time of registration. Please make all checks payable to District 300.

Grades 6-8 students \$105 for the two week session

Location:

The D300 Summer Band is running at Westfield Community School. You will be notified if the session is cancelled due to low enrollment.

Attendance and Discipline:

It is very important that any student absence be communicated to the staff of the D300 Summer Band. Attendance will be taken daily with phone calls made to parents/guardians should a reason for an absence be determined unknown. **If your student is going to be absent (illness included), please call 847-532-7620 and leave a message with your name, your student's name, and your student's grade.** Discipline issues will not be tolerated during summer band. Discipline issues could result in a student being dropped from the program. No refunds will be issued for students dropped for any reason.

Transportation to Summer Band:

District 300 will not provide any transportation to Summer Band programming. Students will need to be dropped off at the Westfield main entrance (door 2) five minutes prior to the start of their session. Students will need to be picked up at the Westfield PDC entrance (door 5) no later than 10 minutes after the end of their session. If you are interested in Car Pooling with other parents from your area, the D300 Summer Band team will be putting together a Car Pool list. If you would like to be involved, please select "yes" on the registration form when prompted.

Authorization for Medical Treatment

If neither parent can be contacted, parent/guardians authorize the school personnel to take such emergency action as may be deemed necessary. Parent/Guardians give consent and permission to any supervising teacher or administrator with whom child is present with, the right on my behalf and in their stand, to arrange for a licensed and certified physician and/or trainers to render and provide immediate treatment to the child as to injuries that may be sustained by the child while participating in Summer Band, whether directly or indirectly, where such injuries consist of, but are not limited to sprains, strains, minor fractures, dislocations, lacerations, contusions, abrasions, and similar injuries, and all without necessity of any further or additional express authorization by parent/guardians, other than for this authorization. The above permission and consent also extends to the right of any supervising teacher or school personnel to arrange for immediate medical treatment by a licensed or certified physician and/or trainer, and for them to apply such emergency techniques as may be necessary to the child where the same, in their judgment, is deemed appropriate by reason of any injury sustained by the child, and where the same, in their judgment, is deemed reasonably necessary to preserve the life or limb of the child.

_____ **Jazz Improvisation/Jazz Rhythm section**– Students playing wind instruments are given an introduction to soloing in typical swing style. Have you ever wanted to learn how to improvise over the 12 bar blues? Here is your chance! Rhythm section students will work with an expert to develop cohesion and the necessary chops to be successful playing in the pocket. If you are wondering what all of these smooth terms mean, sign up for the class to learn more!

_____ **All About My Instrument (6th grade only)** – Are you interested in how your instrument was made? Do you know how mouthpieces were developed or reeds produced? In this class, you will explore what makes your instrument special, including care and maintenance advice.

_____ **ILMEA Prep (7th and 8th grade only)** – It’s time for boot camp, ILMEA Boot Camp. The ILMEA Audition process is rigorous and demanding. This session is designed to help those students wanting to participate in ILMEA. Students will work on audition materials and develop a summer practice plan to adequately prepare for the fall audition.

_____ **World Drumming** – Many cultures use drumming for dance and celebration. In this class, you have the opportunity to explore drumming used throughout the world.
